We hosted FISH on June 4th and 5th. We served 32 families, including 70 adults and 34 children, for a total of 104 people. One family walked and took two buses from Longview to pick up their food. It was going to be a hot day so they dressed appropriately and left home quite early in the morning to catch the first bus. When they spoke to the FISH volunteer on the phone and said they would be taking the bus, the FISH volunteer suggested they might want to wait until next week to get food since all of the churches would be in Longview that week, but the mom said she couldn't wait until Monday to get food, she needed it now. This is an example of how much people rely upon FISH and other food banks to supplement their food supplies. Please know that all of your food and cash donations help the poor and challenged amongst us. Without your support it would be very difficult to carry out this ministry for the poor in our community. Many thanks to our volunteers for setting up tables, gathering food items from the CAP Warehouse and grocery stores, and distributing food: George Brajcich, Joe Brunelle, John Coleman, Dan and Nathan Faber, Dale Goodman, Rich and Betty Hickey, Caleigh Maffett, Cory Mugaas, and Bernie Storm. Our next time to host FISH is August 6th and 7th. Please help refill our pantry shelves; we especially need: canned fruit, soups, stews, chili, veggies and mac&cheese.
