Sacrament Information

Infant Baptism: A preparation program for parents and godparents is required. Once paperwork is submitted, we will register you for preparation and schedule the date for Baptism.

First Reconciliation & First Eucharist: Customarily the reception of these sacraments takes place during 2nd grade. The child will need to have completed one year of religious education the year immediately prior to sacramental preparation and will continue in religious education concurrent with the preparation classes.

Confirmation: Candidates must be 16 years of age to be confirmed. The candidate will need to have completed one year of youth group the year immediately prior to Confirmation preparation. They will also need to attend youth group the year of preparation. Preparation for adult Confirmation takes place in November and the celebration is prior to Lent.

Marriage: Please call the Parish Office at least six months in advance to begin the preparation process. You will set the date for the wedding at the first meeting.

Anointing of the Sick: Please contact the parish office to arrange visitation and sacraments. You may leave a message any time of day or night and someone will get back to you as soon as possible.

Dear Cowlitz and Wahkiakum County Catholics --

On a return trip from Armenia Pope Francis was asked a question about some comments a German Cardinal made in the wake of the massacre inside a gay club in the city of Orlando. The Pope's response garnered significant media attention. The Pope said that Christians owe gay people an apology, which led to widespread speculation on what he meant. The transcripts can be found in full, and I want to encourage you to read them in full.

A key phrase in the press conference was when the Pope said, "The problem is a person that has a condition, that has good will and who seeks God, who are we to judge? And we must accompany them well ... this is what the catechism says, a clear catechism." He adds a few sentences later, "Christians must ask forgiveness for having not accompanied so many choices, so many families ..."

The media focused on that particular aspect that pertains to sexuality, but that wasn't the fullness of the Pope's words. He said, "I think that the Church must not only... ask forgiveness to the gay person who is offended. But she must ask forgiveness to the poor too, to women who are exploited, to children who are exploited for labor. She must ask forgiveness for having blessed so many weapons."

Some are speculating that this represents a change in the Church's moral teaching, but I don't see that in the Pope's comments. The Pope is most distressed about the failure of Christians to accompany people in extremely difficult situations. The Church asks a lot from her members, and it's ok that she does; however, we also need to help people live the demands the Gospel places on them. We have all failed to live the demands in some way.

The life of Jesus of Nazareth models what we are called to do for those that suffer. Jesus came down from heaven and became a human and accompanied people in their darkest moments. As I often remark, this is why our parishes have crucifixes. The crucifix is not a symbol to make us feel guilt or shame. It is a revelation of divine love and a reminder that God has entered into the darkest moments of life and accompanied us through them.

Taking Christ as our model, Christians are called to draw close to people in their darkest moments and accompany them. I know I have failed to do this well in my life as a Catholic and in my ministry as a priest. There are many people who I have failed to support in difficult times, some of them perhaps being our own parishioners. For that, I apologize. I also apologize if I have not been a good role model for you to follow in this important work of mercy.

But don't forget that "The Church" is not merely priests and bishops. The Pope was not speaking just about the need for priests and bishops to apologize. He was speaking about all Catholics and, really, all Christians. He was speaking to you and your need to apologize. If there is anybody who needed your support when they were in a terrible situation and you failed to accompany them I want to encourage you to reach out and apologize. If you need help doing this I will do what I can to assist you.

15. Domingo del Tiempo Ordinario — Ciclo C
Lucas 10, 25-37: "¿Quién es mi prójimo?"

¿Qué debemos hacer en esta vida para llegar a la vida eterna? Esta es la pregunta que le hace un maestro de la ley a Jesús. Su intención no era buena. El Señor le pregunta sobre lo que está escrito y él sabe responder adecuadamente. El Interrogador no pide ninguna aclaración en cuanto al amor a Dios, pero lo que no tiene claro es aquello del amor al prójimo. Sucede lo mismo con muchos cristianos. Tienen un aparente amor a Dios pero en cambio ¡hay que oírles hablar de los demás! ¡Cuánta Intransigencia; cuánta violencia verbal...! Los creyentes nos movemos en el amor en vertical y en el amor horizontal. En la mitología los dioses hacen sus vidas lejos de los seres humanos y sólo entre ellos. El Dios que Jesús nos trae es un Dios de corazón abierto y de inmensa acogida hacia todos las personas. Los judíos de la época de Jesús también hablaban del "prójimo", pero entendían como prójimo sólo a los judíos. El amor que Él nos trae es más universal que las exclusiones que hacemos los seres humanos. Para el Maestro el prójimo es cualquier ser humano, en especial los más débiles y necesitados. Muchas veces me pregunto si nuestra Iglesia de hoy es la aliada de los más desfavorecidos de la sociedad; si nosotros como cristianos somos esos samaritanos convencidos del que aparece herido por causa de los otros. Tenemos que convertirnos a Dios pero también al prójimo. No es suficiente creernos que amamos al prójimo. Es necesario hacer algo provechoso por mi prójimo. El Evangelio no es un cúmulo de buenas intenciones sino una constante provocación a la acción. Si nos quedamos en la belleza de la parábola puede ser que no captemos el mandato final de Jesús: "Vete y haz tú lo mismo." *¿Cómo podemos hacer nuestra conversión al prójimo?* Los cristianos tenemos que tener mucho cuidado de no herir el alma de nuestros prójimos. Nosotros somos portadores de la mayor buena noticia que ha oído nunca la humanidad. Dios se hace uno de nosotros para que nosotros estemos más cerca que nunca de los demás. Acercarse a Dios es tener como compañeros de camino a mis prójimos. No entiendo esa fe siempre excluyente del que no piensa como nosotros. Cuando se vive la fe como exclusión siempre se acaba condenando a los demás. Tenemos que tener siempre cuidado para que nuestra fe sea siempre acogida a los otros, nunca excluir ni condenar a nadie. Dios no ha hecho hermanos de nuestros hermanos no jueces de los demás. Ser cristiano es creer en Dios y en los demás. *¿Qué puedo hacer por los demás?* Nadie te pide que hagas lo que no puedes hacer. Sólo damos lo que tenemos. Lo que nos dice Jesús es que hagamos en lugar de quedarnos pensando o quejándonos. *¿Qué podemos hacer para ver a los demás como prójimos?* El programa del Reino de Dios pasa siempre por el encuentro con los demás. Cada cualidad del Reino que Jesús nos trae siempre hace referencia a los demás: paz, gozo, alegría, justicia, misericordia... El prójimo hoy tiene muchos nombres: familia, amigos, vecinos, desconocidos, conocidos, enemigos... Dice san Juan que quien ama a Dios a quien no ve y, en cambio, no ama al que tiene al lado, es un mentiroso... Ese es el recorrido que va desde el amor que debemos a Dios y a los demás. Dios no es envidioso porque amemos al otro. Él es la fuente de la que tiene que brotar un amor auténtico a los prójimos nuestros de cada día.

Misericordiae Vultus—Año de la Misericordia (Papa Francisco)

14. La peregrinación es un signo peculiar en el Año Santo, porque es imagen del camino que cada persona realiza en su existencia. La vida es una peregrinación y el ser humano es viator, un peregrino que recorre su camino hasta alcanzar la meta anhelada. También para llegar a la Puerta Santa en Roma y en cualquier otro lugar, cada uno deberá realizar, de acuerdo con las propias fuerzas, una peregrinación. Esto será un signo del hecho que también la misericordia es una meta por alcanzar y que requiere compromiso y sacrificio. La peregrinación, entonces, sea estímulo para la conversión: atravesando la Puerta Santa nos dejaremos abrazar por la misericordia de Dios y nos comprometeremos a ser misericordiosos con los demás como el Padre lo es con nosotros.

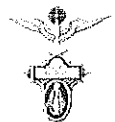
