## Sacrament Information

**Infant Baptism:** A preparation program for parents and godparents is required. Once paperwork is submitted, we will register you for preparation and schedule the date for Baptism.

**First Reconciliation & First Eucharist:** Customarily the reception of these sacraments takes place during 2nd grade. The child will need to have completed one year of religious education the year immediately prior to sacramental preparation and will continue in religious education concurrent with the preparation classes.

**Confirmation:** Candidates must be 16 years of age to be confirmed. The candidate will need to have completed one year of youth group the year immediately prior to Confirmation preparation. They will also need to attend youth group the year of preparation. Preparation for adult Confirmation takes place in November and the celebration is prior to Lent.

**Marriage:** Please call the Parish Office at least six months in advance to begin the preparation process. You will set the date for the wedding at the first meeting.

**Anointing of the Sick:** Please contact the parish office to arrange visitation and sacraments. You may leave a message any time of day or night and someone will get back to you as soon as possible.

Dear Cowlitz and Wahkiakum County Catholics,

Last week I introduced some of our plans for Faith Formation this coming year. We will be offering *The Alpha Course*, our Sunday night Bible Study, a Mass in "Slow Motion," in the coming weeks. If you'd like more info on any of those, please see last week's bulletin or contact the parish offices. This week, we'll focus on our plans for children and youth.

**New Middle School Youth Minister!** After prayerfully considering some of our options we decided it would be best for our youth ministry program to hire a part time youth minister who will focus on serving our Middle School students. You may have seen the position advertised in the bulletin. I'm delighted to announce we have made a hire. Beginning September, Jaime Alvarez will be leading our middle school youth ministry.

Most of you know Jaime because he is Claudia Alvarez's husband. Claudia has been running our children's ministries here at the parish for three years now. Jaime has been helping her out, but now he will be focusing on middle school. Those of you who know Jaime know that he will do very well and that our middle school students will be well served. Welcome Jaime! One of Jaime's first tasks will be to find volunteers to help. If you'd like to help with our middle school youth, please let us know! Middle School youth meet in the school gym at 6:30.

**Children's Religious Education and First Sacraments:** Children's religious education meets on Wednesday nights at 6:30 at St. Rose School. We offer classes for kindergarten through fifth grade (for older students, see above!). We always need classroom teachers and classroom aids, who help students with their work and provide an extra pair of eyes in the classroom. It is a great ministry. For more information, please contact Claudia at the St. Rose parish office.

If you have children entering second grade or older who need to receive their sacraments of penance and first communion, please register your students with Claudia. Our preparation classes meet on certain Sundays throughout the year at 12:30pm. There will be a parent meeting on Monday, September 26<sup>th</sup> at 6pm at St. Rose.

**High School Confirmation:** The Sacrament of Confirmation is ordinarily celebrated during high school in the Archdiocese of Seattle. Typically, you need to be sixteen years of age at the time the sacrament is conferred, which is in May. If you have a student who would like to receive this sacrament, please talk to Joe Buttle at 360-423-3650. This year, our classes will be held on certain **Sundays at 12:30pm** at the St. Rose parish center. There will be a parent meeting on Sunday October 9<sup>th</sup> from 12:30 to 1:30 in the St. Rose parish center.

**Mass Change:** Finally, I need to announce a time change for daily Mass at St. Rose. Beginning in September, weekday Mass on Thursday will be at 10:50am. The reason for this is to accommodate our school community. As many of you know, we offer Mass for our students every week. This time will work much better for our students and teachers. It will also help the priests prepare for school Mass a bit better. The monthly senior Mass will be held together with the school mass. Sorry for any inconvenience this might cause, but it is going to be very good for our students, so I thank you for your support.

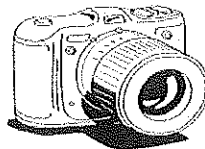

**22. Domingo del Tiempo Ordinario — Ciclo C—  
Lucas 14, 1. 1-14 "Humildad".**

La primera lectura y el Evangelio de hoy nos hablan de una virtud, una actitud muy decisiva para lograr la perfección cristiana: la humildad. Ya en el plano humano, el hombre humilde se gana el afecto de todos: "lo quieren más que al hombre generoso"; dice la primera lectura. Así también en el ejemplo del Evangelio, cuando los invitados ambiciosos buscan los primeros puestos. El honor verdadero nunca nos lo damos a nosotros mismos; lo recibimos de otros. Esto que vale ya entre los hombres, tanto más vale ante Dios. Y en esta ocasión Jesús nos revela un misterio del Reino de Dios: "Todo el que se ensalza, será humillado; y el que se humilla, será ensalzado". Pero, **¿qué significa humildad?** En esto puede haber un peligro de equivocación. Humildad, es muy distinta de sentimientos o complejos de inferioridad: estos son expresiones de desaliento o depresión. En nuestro tiempo actual, muchos sufren de estos complejos o sentimientos, especialmente los melancólicos. Necesitan ante todo una sana confianza sí mismos. ¿Cuál es, pues, el hombre verdaderamente humilde? El hombre humilde es y se siente - por sí solo muy débil, necesitado y defectuoso; pero unido con Dios, es y se siente de un valor muy grande. Humildad se entiende, por eso, como actitud de la creatura limitada y pecadora ante el Dios perfecto y santo. En esa perspectiva, humildad es verdad, porque el humilde conoce y reconoce su debilidad y pequeñez. La usa para vincularse más profundamente con Dios. La verdadera humildad nos hace poner nuestra confianza en Dios y en su misericordia. Hoy se nos invita a vincular nuestro desvalimiento con la omnipotencia de Dios, nuestra pequeñez con la infinitud de Dios, nuestra miseria con la misericordia de Dios. Y el Padre del cielo no puede resistir a la debilidad, cuando es conocida y reconocida por sus hijos. Es como una predilección de Dios ante el hombre humilde. En este mismo sentido nos explica la primera lectura de hoy: "Grande es la misericordia de Dios, revela sus secretos a los humildes". El gran modelo de esta actitud de humildad es la Sma. Virgen. La razón de su pequeñez no es la experiencia de la culpa o del pecado, porque sabemos que ella quedó íntegra durante toda su vida. Su humildad se base en la conciencia de ser creatura ante el Dios omnipotente. Sabe de la distancia infinita entre ella y el Dios eterno. Y se complace en reconocer su pequeñez y limitación humana ante la infinitud de Dios. El grado más profundo de humildad lo encontramos en Jesucristo. Él enseña la necesidad de ser humilde como Él, diciendo: "Aprended de mí que soy manso y humilde de corazón" (Mt 11,29). En Cristo, la humildad se une con su disponibilidad servicial para con el prójimo. Porque el hombre realmente humilde, siempre es servicial y se pone desinteresadamente a disposición de los hermanos. Así enseña también el Evangelio de hoy: que nos demos a los demás, sin buscar una retribución, sólo esperando la recompensa de Dios al final del camino. Hermanos, también en esta Eucaristía Cristo sigue sirviéndonos a nosotros, siendo nuestra ofrenda y nuestro alimento. Cristo eucarístico es el signo del supremo servicio al hombre: de su salvación eterna, de su seguridad de llegar, un día, a la Casa del Padre.

**Misericordiae Vultus—Año de la Misericordia (Papa Francisco)**

**18.** Durante este Año Santo tengo la intención de enviar los Misioneros de la Misericordia. Serán un signo de la solicitud materna de la Iglesia por el Pueblo de Dios, para que entre en profundidad en la riqueza de este misterio tan fundamental para la fe. Serán, sobre todo, signo vivo de cómo el Padre acoge cuantos están en busca de su perdón. Serán misioneros de la misericordia porque serán los artífices ante todos de un encuentro cargado de humanidad, fuente de liberación, rico de responsabilidad, para superar los obstáculos y retomar la vida nueva del Bautismo. Se dejarán conducir en su misión por las palabras del Apóstol: « Dios sometió a todos a la desobediencia, para tener misericordia de todos » (Rm 11,32). Todos entonces, sin excluir a nadie, están llamados a percibir el llamamiento a la misericordia. Los misioneros vivan esta llamada conscientes de poder fijar la mirada sobre Jesús, « sumo sacerdote misericordioso y digno de fe » (Hb 2,17)

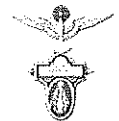
