Sacrament Information

Infant Baptism: A preparation program for parents and godparents is required. Once paperwork is submitted, we will register you for preparation and schedule the date for Baptism.

First Reconciliation & First Eucharist: Customarily the reception of these sacraments takes place during 2nd grade. The child will need to have completed one year of religious education the year immediately prior to sacramental preparation and will continue in religious education concurrent with the preparation classes.

Confirmation: Candidates must be 16 years of age to be confirmed. The candidate will need to have completed one year of youth group the year immediately prior to Confirmation preparation. They will also need to attend youth group the year of preparation. Preparation for adult Confirmation takes place in November and the celebration is prior to Lent.

Marriage: Please call the Parish Office at least six months in advance to begin the preparation process. You will set the date for the wedding at the first meeting.

Anointing of the Sick: Please contact the parish office to arrange visitation and sacraments. You may leave a message any time of day or night and someone will get back to you as soon as possible.

Dear Cowlitz and Wahkiakum County Catholics,

I don't remember the first time I went to Confession very well. I do remember the second quite vividly. I was a senior in high school and had completely forgotten what I was supposed to say or what I was supposed to do. I had no bad experiences in the confessional, but I remember relatives and teachers and other people from our parish sending subtle messages that this was something I was supposed to be afraid of. Our pastor seemed nice and I wasn't afraid to talk to him, but that alone confused me. Wasn't I supposed to be afraid?

I walked into confession and was greeted nicely. Not particularly warmly, but certainly not rudely. It was just... normal. Then I told the priest that this was my second confession ever and that I hadn't been to confession in a long time. The priest's demeanor changed instantly. He said words of welcome and was happy that I had found the courage to come to repent of things I knew I had done wrong. I confessed my sins and my pastor explained some ways in which these sins may have impacted me and people I love most. As I sort of expected, the experience of the aforementioned friends, relatives, and teachers was nothing like what I was experiencing at that moment.

After hearing some helpful words of encouragement, the priest advised me to offer my act of contrition. I laughed and said, "I have no idea what that even is!" He chuckled and explained it's a prayer in which we express our sorrow for our sins and ask for God's help. He told me I could make up my own or I could read the one sitting by the kneeler. I opted for the second option and prayed the prayer on the card. Then he offered the prayer of absolution which forgave me of my sins and I left. Ever since then I've received the sacrament of reconciliation regularly (although I still need the prayer card to help me remember the act of contrition!).

The sacrament of reconciliation is a sacrament I love to celebrate. First of all, I love to receive it as a penitent. I confess my sins to my brother priests as well! But I also love to celebrate this sacrament as a priest. I remember how good I felt coming out of the confessional as a senior in high school, and I want everyone to experience that wonderful feeling of being forgiven for themselves. There are many opportunities to receive this sacrament in our area, and I especially want to invite those of you who might be in the same situation I was in high school to take advantage. I was hesitant, a little intimidated by the formality of the sacrament, and perhaps even a little unsure if confessing sins to a priest was what God wanted me to do. But I went ahead and did it and I'm glad. It helped.

We currently offer confession at St. Rose on Saturdays at 3:30 p.m., and Wednesdays at 5 p.m. We also offer the sacrament in Castle Rock on Sundays at 8 a.m. and in Kelso on Tuesdays at 11:45 a.m.. You are always welcome to schedule an appointment for confession as well. We will offer our annual Advent penance service, on December 13th at 11 a.m. It will be a daytime service this year just to see how it works. We will have several priests available for confession. I hope you will take advantage of this opportunity to experience God's mercy and forgiveness, and to finally let go of any guilt you may feel from past mistakes.

II Domingo de ADVIENTO—Ciclo B

10 de Diciembre del 2017

Marcos 1,1 – 8

"Comienzo del Evangelio de Jesucristo, Hijo de Dios. Conforme está escrito en Isaias el profeta: Mira, envío mi mensajero delante de ti, el que ha de preparar tu camino. Voz del que clama en el desierto: Preparad el camino del Señor, enderezad sus sendas, apareció Juan bautizando en el desierto, proclamando un bautismo de conversión para perdón de los pecados. Acudía a él gente de toda la región de Judea y todos los de Jerusalén, y eran bautizados por él en el río Jordán, confesando sus pecados. Juan llevaba un vestido de pie de camello; y se alimentaba de langostas y miel silvestre. Y proclamaba: «Detrás de mí viene el que es más fuerte que yo; y no soy digno de desatarle, inclinándome, la correa de sus sandalias. Yo os he bautizado con agua, pero él os bautizará con el Espíritu Santo.»"

COMENTARIO.

Juan Bautista había predicado un bautismo de arrepentimiento, pero prometió que tras él venía alguien "más poderoso" que nos bautizaría con el Espíritu Santo. Pero, ¿cuál es la diferencia?

El bautismo de Juan se enfocaba en el pasado, en el perdón de los pecados ya cometidos, porque él quería que las personas superaran su anterior vida de pecado. El Espíritu Santo se enfoca en el futuro, y viene a moldearnos y transformarnos para llevarnos al Reino de los cielos.

El Bautismo de Juan tenía un propósito: lograr el perdón. Pero el Espíritu Santo tiene muchos propósitos. Por ejemplo, nos revela el amor de Dios; nos ayuda a entender la Escritura; nos enseña a vivir como hermanos; mantiene unida a la Iglesia y nos mueve a trabajar por el Reino de Dios, y mucho más.

Cuando somos bautizados en Cristo, recibimos las dos bendiciones. Se nos borran los pecados, y también recibimos el Espíritu Santo.

Por tanto, no solo experimentamos el perdón de Dios, sino que invitamos al Espíritu Santo a que actúe en todas las demás áreas de nuestra vida. Y así percibimos el amor de Dios. Nos hacemos más amables, se despierta en nosotros el deseo de cuidar a otros que están sufriendo y adquirimos la Fortaleza necesaria para no ceder a las tentaciones.
