## Sacrament Information

**Infant Baptism:** A preparation program for parents and godparents is required. Once paperwork is submitted, we will register you for preparation and schedule the date for Baptism.

**First Reconciliation & First Eucharist:** Customarily the reception of these sacraments takes place during 2nd grade. The child will need to have completed one year of religious education the year immediately prior to sacramental preparation and will continue in religious education concurrent with the preparation classes.

**Confirmation:** Candidates must be 16 years of age to be confirmed. The candidate will need to have completed one year of youth group the year immediately prior to Confirmation preparation. They will also need to attend youth group the year of preparation. Preparation for adult Confirmation takes place in November and the celebration is prior to Lent.

**Marriage:** Please call the Parish Office at least six months in advance to begin the preparation process. You will set the date for the wedding at the first meeting.

**Anointing of the Sick:** Please contact the parish office to arrange visitation and sacraments. You may leave a message any time of day or night and someone will get back to you as soon as possible.

Dear Parishioners

Sin has real consequences. When God created us, he placed love for God and others within us. Our faith teaches us that sin removes that love from within us and that love for other things replaces it. But this isn't merely a theological or spiritual reality. It is psychological. Our love for others dries up if we don't spend real, quality time with them. College students know this.

When I graduated from high school I remember my friends and I thinking we would always be close friends and that nothing would come between us. Well, we all went to different colleges. We didn't spend time with each other, and we made a ton of new friends who we spent time with. Our phone calls to each other became fewer and further in between and it wasn't long before we started to prefer our college friends over our high school friends.

It's the same with God. If we choose to spend time with other things, we will start to love those other things more than God. It's really that simple. We will love our sin more than we love God and that will prevent us from entering eternal life. Yes, God loves us unconditionally. But heaven isn't about whether or not God loves us. It's about whether or not we love God. We cannot experience the joy of being with God forever if we do not love him. Repentance and confession of sin is a way that God heals us from the damage our sin does to us and restores our love for God.

Confronting sin is not easy. A good analogy for confronting sin is anyone who hates getting up in the morning. When I was in high school, my mom would wake me up in the morning by turning on the lights. I hated it, so I'd dive under the covers trying to cling to some type of fantasy that I could stay there forever. She'd then rip the covers off, and I hated feeling that cold blast of air. This had become a daily routine, and it is similar to what we have to all go through in the spiritual life.

Sometimes when we are forced to confront our sin it is like having somebody turn the lights on after we've been asleep. Our instincts might be to dive under the covers of denial. When we actually try to give up our sins, it can be like somebody ripping the covers off and feeling the cold blast of reality. When any of this happens we might lash out at people, including priests and bishops who are the ones responsible for waking us up and helping us to face the reality of sin.

If we are going to get the most out of Lent and experience the Joy of Easter, we have to wake up. We might want to live in denial that our sins are not a big deal, and that God doesn't have plans for us, but when we do this, we deceive ourselves. God is merciful and forgiving, and it is revealed that he is patient with struggling sinners. However, God also reveals his judgement is harsh for those who choose to live in denial and remain lukewarm in their faith. He wants us to prepare for judgement.

One way we can prepare is the sacrament of reconciliation, where we confess our sins to a priest and he offers us forgiveness in God's name. Well, there is a great little series about the sacrament of reconciliation on Formed.org, called *Forgiven*. *Forgiven* was produced by the Augustine Institute, which also produced the materials we use for baptism preparation and marriage preparation. I love the Augustine institute because what they produce is very high quality. I've seen two episodes of *Forgiven* and I'm impressed by it, especially the first episode. They have the best Catholic speakers contributing to the series, including my personal favorite, Matt Fradd. I'd like to encourage you to watch this series. You can find it simply by visiting [formed.org](http://formed.org) and entering our parish code, FTFWEZ. If you'd like, you can also make use of the study guides which can be found on the website as well. If you haven't been to confession in a while, I think you'd benefit from watching this series. Our Annual Lenten Reconciliation Service is Thursday, February 22<sup>nd</sup>, at 6:30pm at St. Rose. I hope you'll be there to take advantage of this great sacrament of healing.
